Monitoring Requirements Not Met for Steelton Water Authority

Our water system violated several drinking water standards over the past year. Even though these were not emergencies, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we did to correct these situations.

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During 2018 we failed to monitor for Hexachlorocyclopentadiene (SOC) and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time.

What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time.

The table below lists the contaminant(s) we did not properly test for during the last year, how often we are supposed to sample for Hexachlorocyclopentadiene and how many samples we are supposed to take, how many samples we took, when samples should have been taken, and the date on which follow-up samples were (or will be) taken.

Hexachlorocyclopentadiene	1 sample annually	0	Quarter with highest historical result	2/27/2019

What happened? What was done?

In February 2019, the Steelton Water Authority was notified by PADEP that it failed to monitor for Hexachlorocyclopentadiene in 2018. On 2/27/2019, a test for Hexachlorocyclopentadiene was taken from the entry point of the Water Plant and the results were ND (non-detectable).
