Steelton Receives Grant for Community Gardens

The Borough of Steelton was awarded a total of \$10,000 to provide funding for the construction of two (2) organic community gardens where all produce will be freely available to community members along with urban agriculture education.

Steelton was one of five (5) municipalities in the country to receive funding through the Healthy Babies Initiative. The Initiative, made up of Healthy Babies Bright Futures (HBBF) and the Mayors Innovation Project (MIP), granted funding to five municipalities whose proposals represented the ability to scale and tailor one of five existing strategies to equitably reduce neurotoxic exposures for babies with resilience co-benefits.

Learn About the Mental Health Co-Responder Program

The Steelton Borough Police Department is proud to announce that we now have a mental health co-responder on our team. This model of criminal justice diversion pairs law enforcement and behavioral health specialists to intervene and respond to behavioral health-related calls for police service. These teams utilize the combined expertise of the officer and the behavioral health specialist to de-escalate situations and help link individuals with behavioral health issues to appropriate services.

Jordan Rolko (pictured to the right) joined the Steelton Police Department in March and has made an immediate impact within the community. Jordan responds to calls involving mental health issues and provides resources and treatment services that police may not be as familiar with. The goal is to reduce serious mental illness within the criminal justice system and provide alternatives to arrest and incarceration.

Register Your Home Surveillance Cameras

The Steelton Borough Police Department is seeking residents and businesses to register their home surveillance cameras. The goal of the camera registry program is to deter crime and promote public safety through collaboration between the Steelton Borough Police and the community we serve. Accordingly, all camera registrants agree to the following terms and conditions:

1. Any footage containing to/or related to criminal activity may be collected for use by the Steelton Police Department as evidence during any stage of a criminal proceeding.
2. Relevant information is reserved for official use by the Steelton Police Department and will not be released to any member of the general public or press.
3. If necessary, the Steelton Police Department will contact you directly using the information provided to request the appropriate video surveillance footage.
4. Under no circumstances shall registrants construe that they are acting as an agent/employee of the Steelton Police Department through the camera registry program.
5. Under no circumstances shall the Steelton Police Department utilize any information obtained to view footage/feeds directly from cameras owned by registrants.
