Codes Department Reminder About Grass, Weeds & Trash Cans

Maintaining weeds is your responsibility. You must pull the weeds in your sidewalk.
Grass and Weeds shall not exceed a height of 8 inches

All properties are required to have trash service. All trash must be placed for pick-up in cans provided by Harrisburg City. Each can must be secured and covered. All trash containers cannot be placed for pick-up prior to 12:00 PM (noon) the day prior to pick-up. All trash containers shall be removed from curbside or location adjacent to street or alley and returned to their storage area within the property line within 12 hours of the actual collection.
