- Vanessa Bowers – Got an email from Dave Drayer regarding speeding on Pine Street and requested speed bumps from Columbia Street to the Borough line. Said vehicles are traveling 50 mph or more and has not seen police presence for speed patrolling. Segina stated that is a state road and goes through PennDOT. Shaub stated they would have to put lines down to run speed and approval goes through PennDOT. Bowers asked when they plan to do that and Shaub replied anytime. He explained that PennDOT never put the lines back that were above Reading Street after construction. They put them on local roads like HarrisburgSt and Frank S Brown Blvd. It was asked by Dent if they can reach out to PennDOT. Shaub said he will contact them.

The motion passed unanimously.*

*Mr. Segina made a motion to terminate Mr. Teddy Cleckner effective immediately, seconded by Vice President Woods. The motion passed unanimously.*

*Mr. Segina made a motion to advertise the public works sewer position effective immediately, Seconded by Mr. Slade. The motion passed unanimously.*

*Adjournment: With no other business to discuss, a motion was made by Mr. Segina and seconded by Mr. Slade to adjourn. The motion passed unanimously, and the meeting adjourned at 7:52 PM.*
